Mitral regurgitation is leakage of blood backward through the mitral valve each time the left LIGHT HEADED of the heart contracts. Midodrine is a drug that narrows both arteries and veins, helping prevent blood pooling. This will allow more blood to flow to your brain. This positional change results in decreased blood flow to the brain. Lightheadedness may be accompanied by nausea and dizziness.
